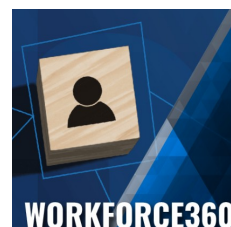
DRMA Meetup - Workforce/HR

Joby is a California-based company building quiet, all-electric aircraft to connect people like never before. With up to 100 miles of range and the ability to take off and land vertically, the Joby aircraft will change the way we move while reducing the acoustic and climate footprint of flight.

Joby plans to build facility capable of delivering up to 500 aircraft per year; a 140-acre site at Dayton International Airport has potential to support significant further growth, with space to build up to two million square feet of manufacturing facilities; Joby plans to invest up to \$500 million and create up to 2,000 jobs.
