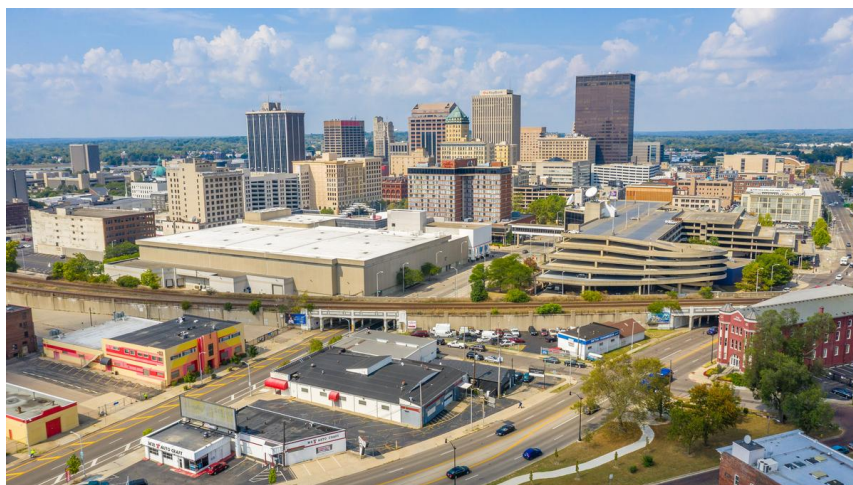

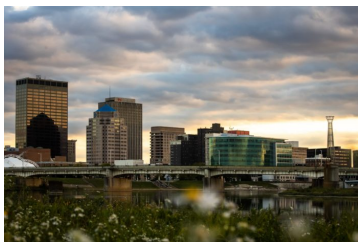


Now Hiring! Communications and Economic Development Manager
